St. Anthony Parish Center FAQs (PART 1)



In response to questions from parishioners, the Development Office has prepared a series of Frequently Asked Questions regarding the St. Anthony Parish Center. We welcome your questions and invite you to contact us using the email below.

Q: Why does St. Anthony need a new Parish Center?

St. Anthony Catholic Parish is thriving, and nearly every Mass is at capacity. As more families move to Florida and more people are drawn to our faith, the needs of our parish community continue to grow. In addition, many of our ministries currently lack adequate meeting space. The new Parish Center will provide modern, functional facilities that support parish engagement, strengthen our ministries, and help us better serve the broader community.

Q: What is the Parish Center?

The Parish Center is an expansion of the Church's ministry and community outreach. This two-story, 17,000-square-foot facility is designed to accommodate a wide range of parish activities and events. It will feature multiple large meeting rooms, a spacious event venue, a service kitchen, a hospitality bar, an outdoor balcony, administrative offices, and storage areas. The facility will be equipped with modern technology and new furnishings to support the needs of our parish community.

Q: Why does the Parish Center look modern while the church and school carry a traditional design?

The Parish Center serves a very different purpose from that of St. Anthony Catholic Church. Its simple and understated design is intentional, ensuring that it complements rather than competes with the Church's architectural beauty. The Parish Center will play a supporting role by providing essential space and services for parish ministries and community activities. The Parish Center's placement will also allow for additional parking in front of the building, providing convenient access to both the Church and the Parish Center.

Q: Who is involved with the fundraising?

Fundraising is essential to both the construction and long-term maintenance of the new Parish Center. We hope the entire St. Anthony Catholic Parish community will participate and support this important project. The Development Office leads all fundraising initiatives, including campaign communications, donor outreach, and fundraising events.

Q: What are the fundraising financial goals?

Fundraising for the St. Anthony Parish Center began several years ago, and to date, nearly \$5.5 million has been raised. These funds enabled the parish to prepare the property adjacent to the Church and begin Phase One of the construction plan. With construction now underway, fundraising efforts will continue. Our original fundraising goal was \$7 million; however, due to significant increases in construction and material costs over the past several years, we anticipate reviewing and adjusting that goal as needed.

Q: When can I make a donation?
