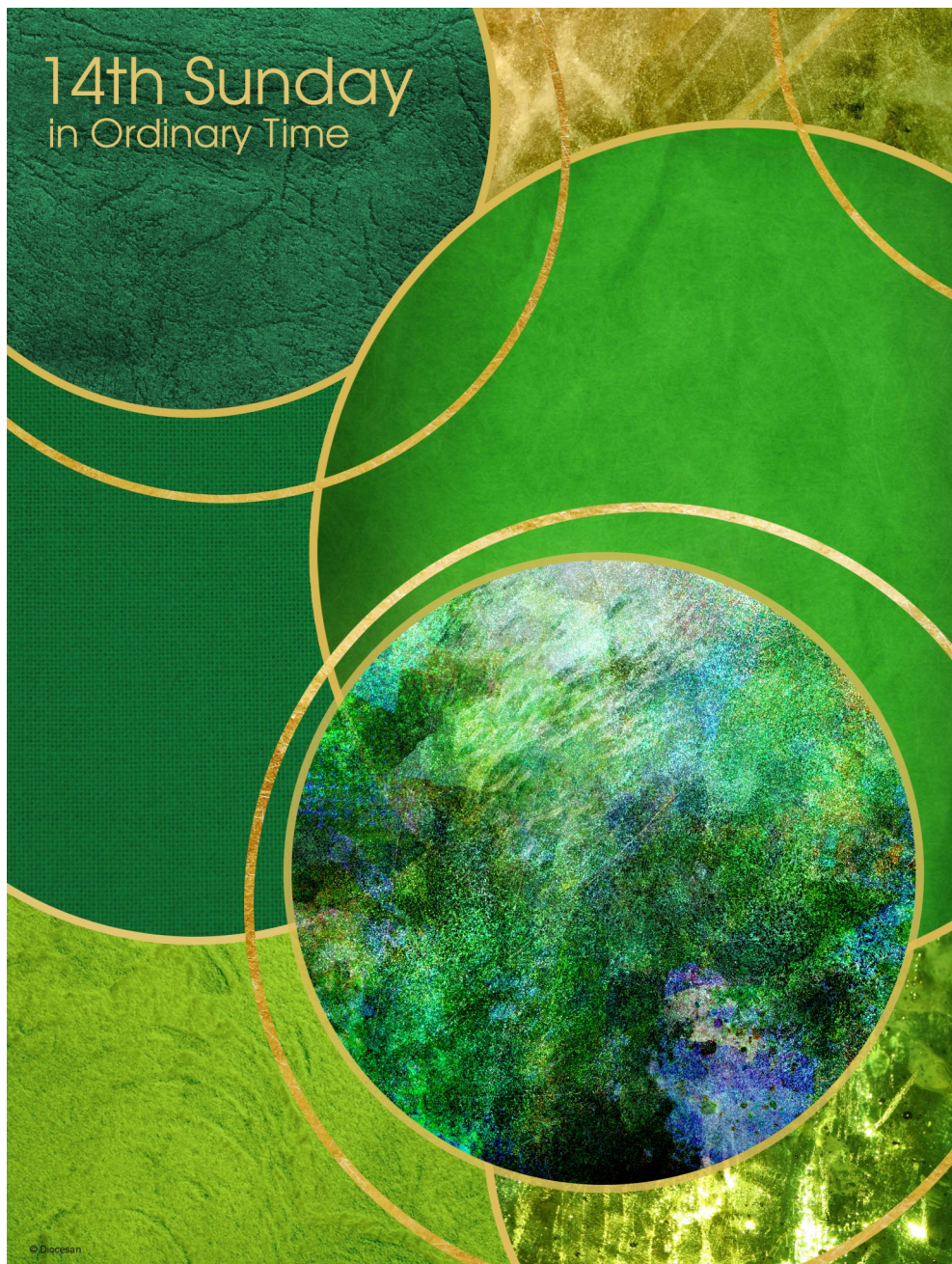

## St. Anthony Parish Center Construction Update

The new Parish Center is being constructed adjacent to the Church and Rectory on SE 2nd Street. Approved in 2025, the project is progressing on schedule with an anticipated completion timeline of approximately two years.

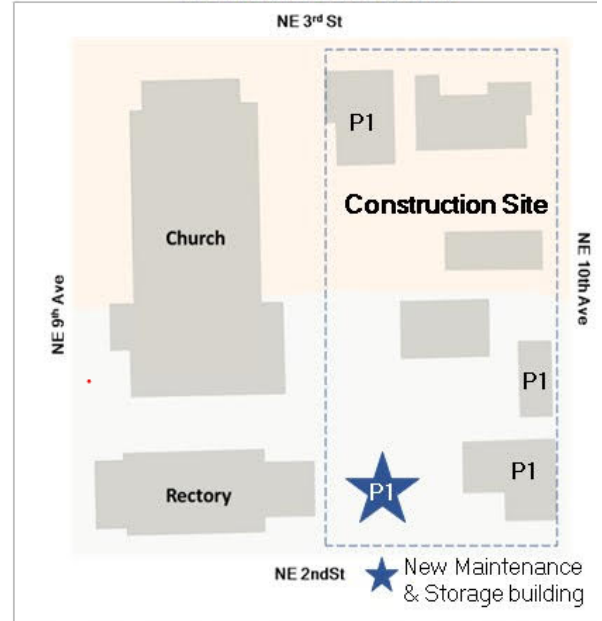
Under the leadership of Father Rolando and in partnership with Gantt Builders, a respected local contractor experienced in residential, commercial, and Catholic parish construction projects, (i.e. Assumption Catholic Church, St. Joan of Arc, St. Jude Catholic School, Sacred Heart Outreach Center, St. Therese de Lisieux, Our Lady Queen of The Apostles), work is advancing steadily.

Phase One includes the demolition of three existing buildings, site preparation, and construction of a new maintenance and storage facility that will serve both St. Anthony Church and the future Parish Center. Parishioners are welcome to view the progress from outside the construction fence; however, for safety reasons, please do not enter the fenced construction area.

Upon completion, the new Parish Center will enhance St. Anthony's mission by providing meeting rooms, a large event space, and additional parking to better serve the Church and Parish Center.
