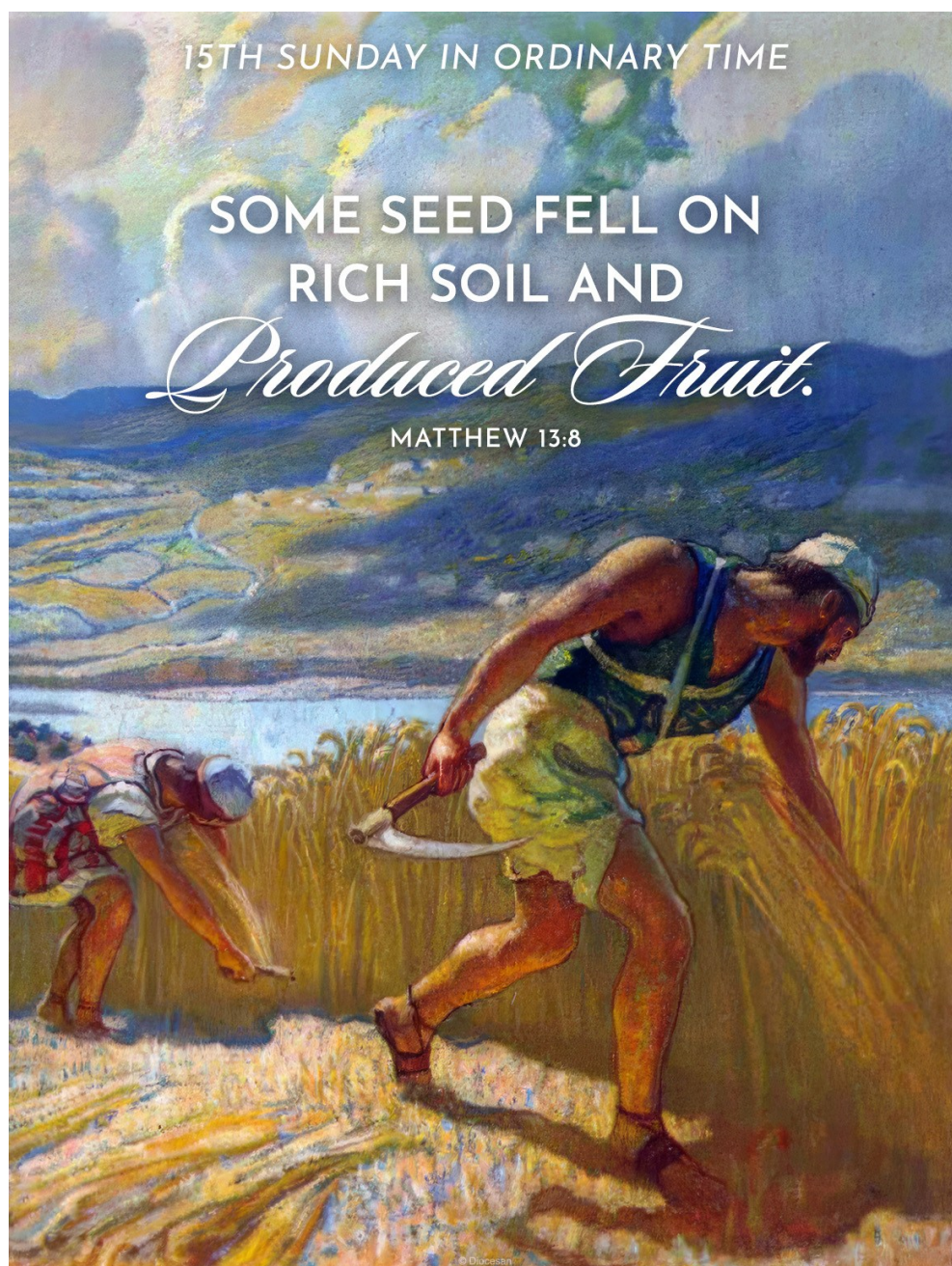

**INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS PERTAINING TO
THE PRIESTLY FRATERNITY OF SAINT PIUS X
JULY 2026 - ARCHDIOCESE OF MIAMI**

1. The full statement to the faithful from the Archdiocese of Miami is available on the Archdiocese of Miami website: <https://www.miamiarch.org/>
2. On July 1, 2026, after proper warnings and communications from the Holy See, the Priestly Fraternity of Saint Pius X (SSPX) proceeded with the ordination of bishops without the mandate of the Holy Father. The next day, the Dicastery of the Doctrine of the Faith (DDF) issued a decree and explanatory note that the actions on the part of SSPX constituted a delict of schism which has an attached penalty, namely the "*latae sententiae*" excommunication.
3. For those seeking an opportunity to attend Latin Mass, the Archdiocese of Miami offers the ministry of the Fraternity of Saint Peter (FSSP), which is in union with the Holy See. The Masses are celebrated in Our Lady of Belen Chapel on Sundays at 10 a.m.; and the chapel of Our Lady of Mercy Cemetery on weekdays at 7:30 a.m. (<https://latinmassmiami.org/mass-times>)
4. The Priestly Fraternity of Saint Pius X (SSPX) **SHOULD NOT BE CONFUSED** with St. Pius X Roman Catholic Parish, located at 2511 N. Ocean Blvd. (A1A), Fort Lauderdale, FL 33305. St. Pius X Roman Catholic Parish is a parish of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Miami and is in full communion with the Roman Catholic Church.
5. To avoid confusion or misinformation, if you need information, clarification, have questions, or are seeking spiritual direction or guidance, please call the Church Office at (954) 463-4614 to schedule a meeting with a priest.
