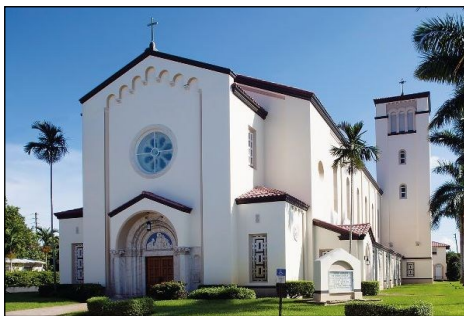

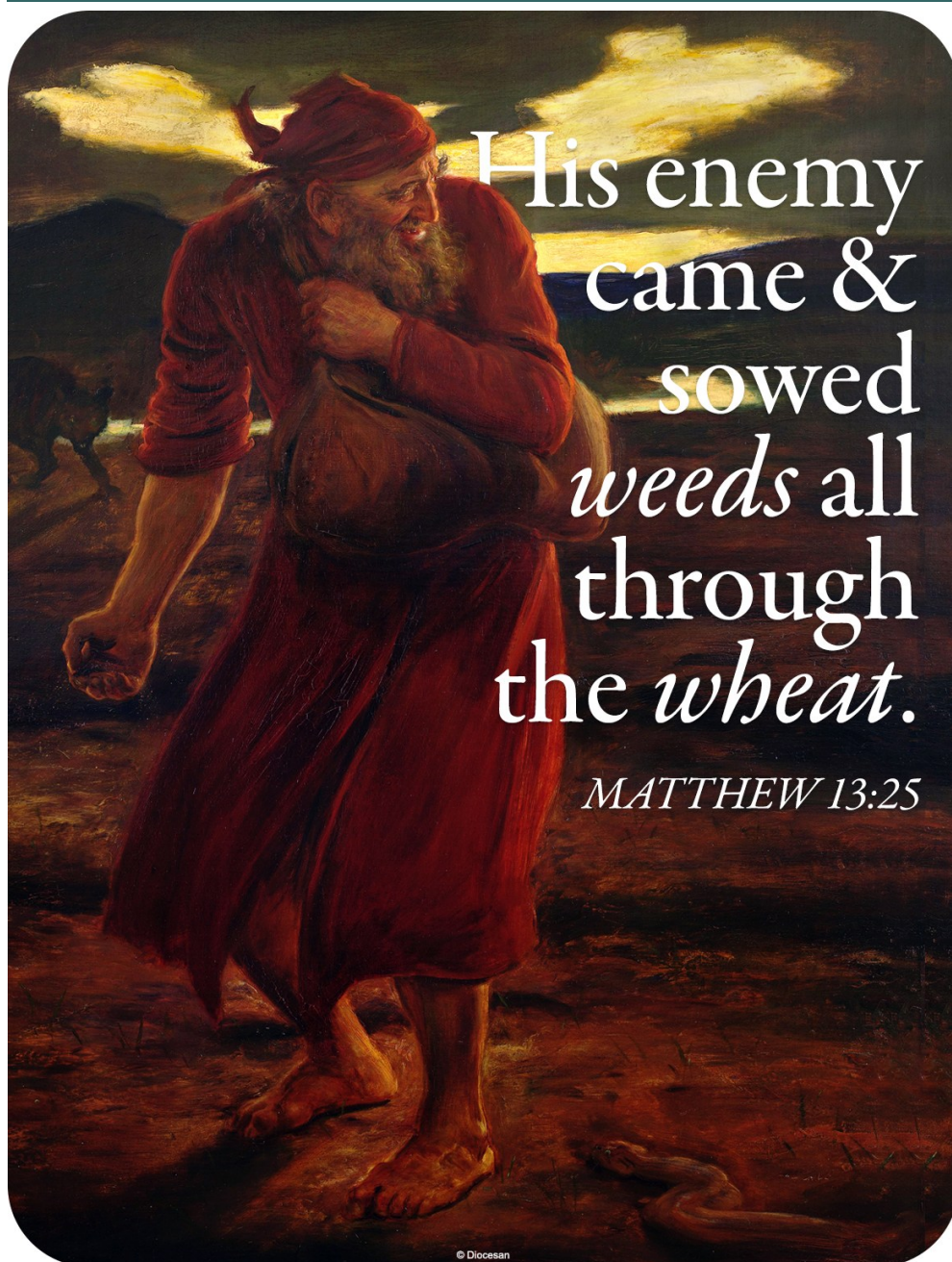

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

16TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Dear Parish Family,

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus tells the parable of the wheat and the weeds. At first glance, we may wonder why the landowner allows both to grow together. Yet Jesus reminds us that God is patient, merciful, and never gives up on us. He sees what we cannot see and works in ways that often surpass our understanding.

It is easy to become discouraged when we encounter evil in the world, division in our communities, or weaknesses in ourselves. The temptation is to judge quickly or lose hope. Instead, Jesus invites us to trust in God's timing and to focus on becoming good wheat—disciples who bear the fruits of faith, kindness, forgiveness, and love.

Our parish is called to be a field where God's grace can flourish. Each act of charity, each prayer offered, each child taught the faith, each family strengthened, and each person welcomed brings the Kingdom of God a little closer to our community.
