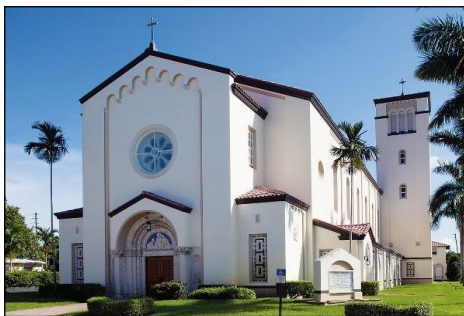

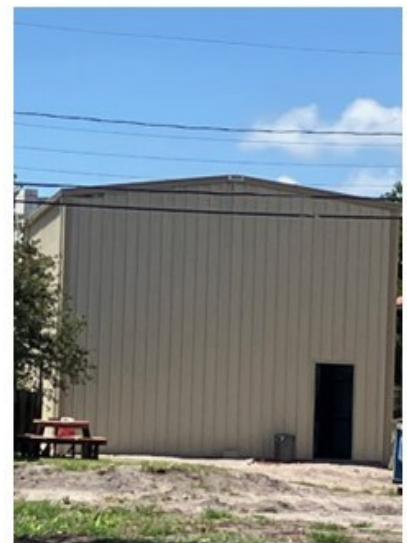
St. Anthony Parish Center Making Progress!

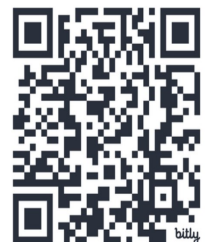
