Dear Parishioners,

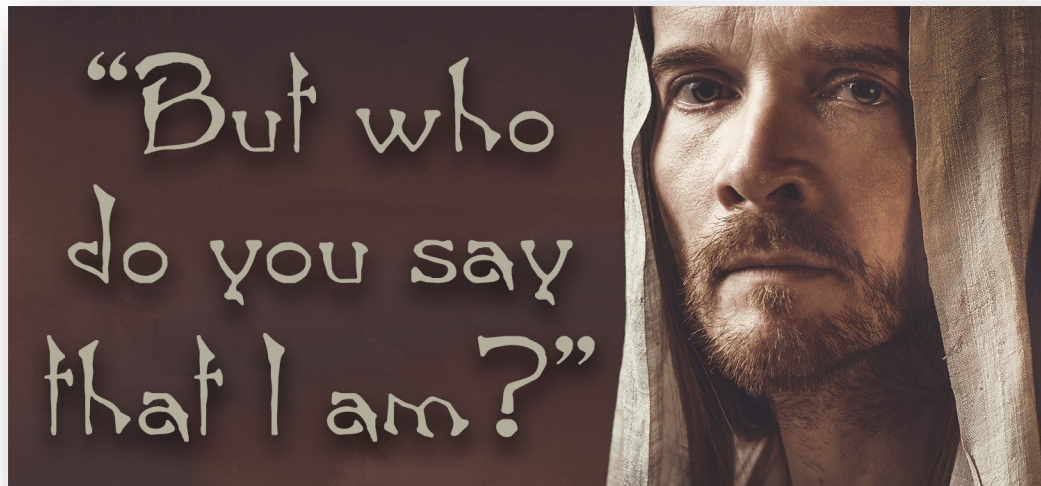

Our teachers happily welcomed students last week to the 2020-2021 school year! Parents and students were able to attend our Virtual Open House to meet their teachers and hear what the beginning of the school year would be like. We welcomed our Pre-K students back to campus. Our K-8 students were welcomed by their teachers on our online platform. Please keep our students, parents, teachers, and staff in your prayers.

ALL VISITORS AND VOLUNTEERS must enter the school through the main gate, check in at the school office, and wear a photo ID badge while on campus. To receive an ID badge and to volunteer at school, you MUST meet the 3 requirements from Archdiocese of Miami as follows:

1) VOLUNTEER PLEDGE TO PROMOTE SAFE ENVIRONMENT: All volunteers must electronically sign a Volunteer Pledge to Promote Safe Environment form which is reflected in your Virtus account. If you do not have internet access, a hard copy is available in the Front Office.

2) VIRTUS: All volunteers must attend a Virtus training course offered through the Archdiocese of Miami. Please go to www.virtus.org and register for a class. A copy of your current Virtus training report is required to be on file with Saint Anthony Catholic School before anyone can volunteer in the school or church. There is no fee for this class and you only need to attend the Virtus session once; however, there are “continuing education” bulletins that you must read and answer monthly to keep your training active. To see your training bulletins, please go to www.virtus.org. If you have not kept up with your online training bulletins, you may have a suspended account.

3) FINGERPRINTING: All volunteers are required to be fingerprinted digitally by the Archdiocese of Miami every five years. You must register online by accessing www.fieldprintflorida.com and following these instructions:

- Click “Schedule an appointment” (registration can be done in English or Spanish)
- Create a secure username/password and enter the Fieldprint scheduling system
- In the “Reason why you need to be fingerprinted” screen, select the web link: “I know my

Fieldprint Code”. Please note that the access code is case sensitive. **Code for School Volunteer: FPAQMSchoolVol**

- Provide all the information requested. This information is required by the FDLE/FBI in order to process the criminal search.
- At this point, the website will prompt the applicant for the information required to find a local fingerprinting facility and schedule an appointment. Instructions, directions, maps and photos will all be provided directly online.
- If additional questions or problems arise, please contact Fieldprint customer service at: 1-800-799-1067 or email: CustomerService@fieldprint.com. Or select the “Contact Us” link on the website. Results of the screening will be provided to the Archdiocese of Miami Background Check Department. These results will be forwarded to Saint Anthony Catholic School.

IMPORTANT: you must bring with you 2 valid forms of identification for the fingerprints.
