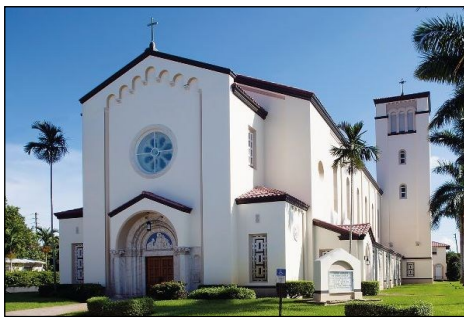

PASTOR'S MESSAGE**

*August 23, 2026
21st Sunday in Ordinary Time*

Dear Parish Family,

This Sunday's Gospel brings us to one of the most important questions in all of Scripture. Jesus asks his disciples: "Who do you say that I am?"

Peter answers on behalf of all of them: "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." And Jesus blesses Peter and entrusts him with a special mission: "You are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my Church."

Peter's confession of faith reminds us that our Christian life begins with a personal relationship with Jesus. It is not enough to know what others say about Him. Each one of us must eventually answer the question: Who is Jesus for me?

For us as a parish community, this question is especially important. We have many activities, ministries, programs, and responsibilities. We work hard to build a strong parish and school community. All of these things are valuable, but they must always lead us back to the center: Jesus Christ. He is the reason we gather, the foundation of our community, and the One who gives meaning to everything we do.

Jesus also reminds us that the Church is built upon the faith of the apostles and that we are called to remain united with the Church. Like Peter, we may have weaknesses and limitations, but God can still use us to accomplish His mission.

As we continue our journey together as the Saint Anthony family, let us renew our faith in Christ. May our parish be a community where people can encounter Jesus, discover His love, and hear His invitation to become His faithful disciples.

And may we never be afraid to answer, with Peter and with the whole Church: "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."

May this confession of faith guide our families, our school, our ministries, and our entire parish community. And may everything we do always lead us closer to Jesus, the foundation and center of our lives.

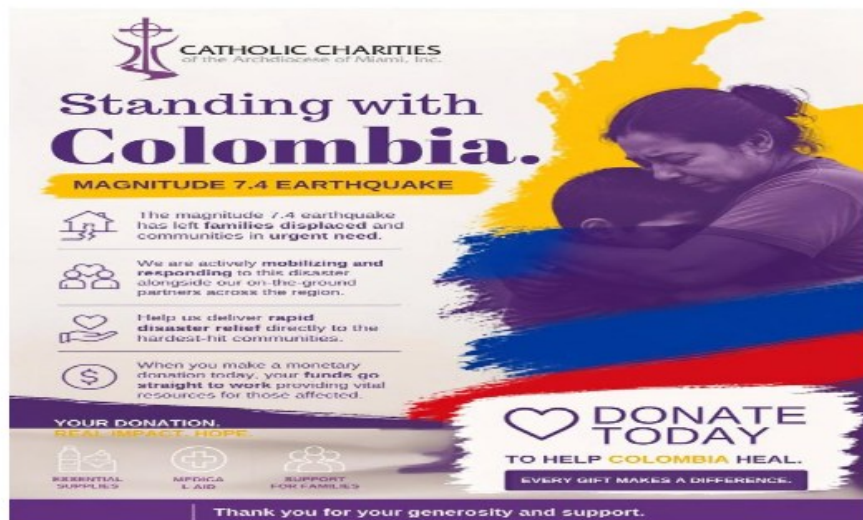

PARISH RELIGIOUS EDUCATION PROGRAM-PREP: Parents are offered support in the faith formation and sacrament preparation of their children on Sundays beginning 9/20/2026 from 10:15 a.m. until 11:30 a.m. on the St. Anthony School Campus. New and returning families may contact the PREP Office at 954-467-7749 or religioused@stanthonnyftl.org for registration and details about the sessions. Adults may consider assisting a catechist (teacher) as a way of volunteering in PREP. Teen aides are vital to the Program and are recognized with verification of service hours for high school commitment.

All volunteers 18 and over must be fingerprinted through the Archdiocese of Miami and Virtus trained.

HOMELESS MINISTRY FOOD DRIVE: *For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink (Matt.25:35).*

We have often heard these words spoken by Jesus, and through our weekly contributions of non-perishable food and hygiene items, we respond to Jesus. In addition we are collecting clean plastic grocery bags for food distribution and empty clean egg cartons for 6 or 12 eggs. These items can be dropped at the Parish Office or you can bring them to the Sacristy on Sunday. If you know of anyone in need of groceries, there is a drive through grocery distribution each Friday from 1:30-3:15 PM at Blessed Sacrament Church on Oakland Park Blvd. First time Individuals must provide proof of Broward County residency.
