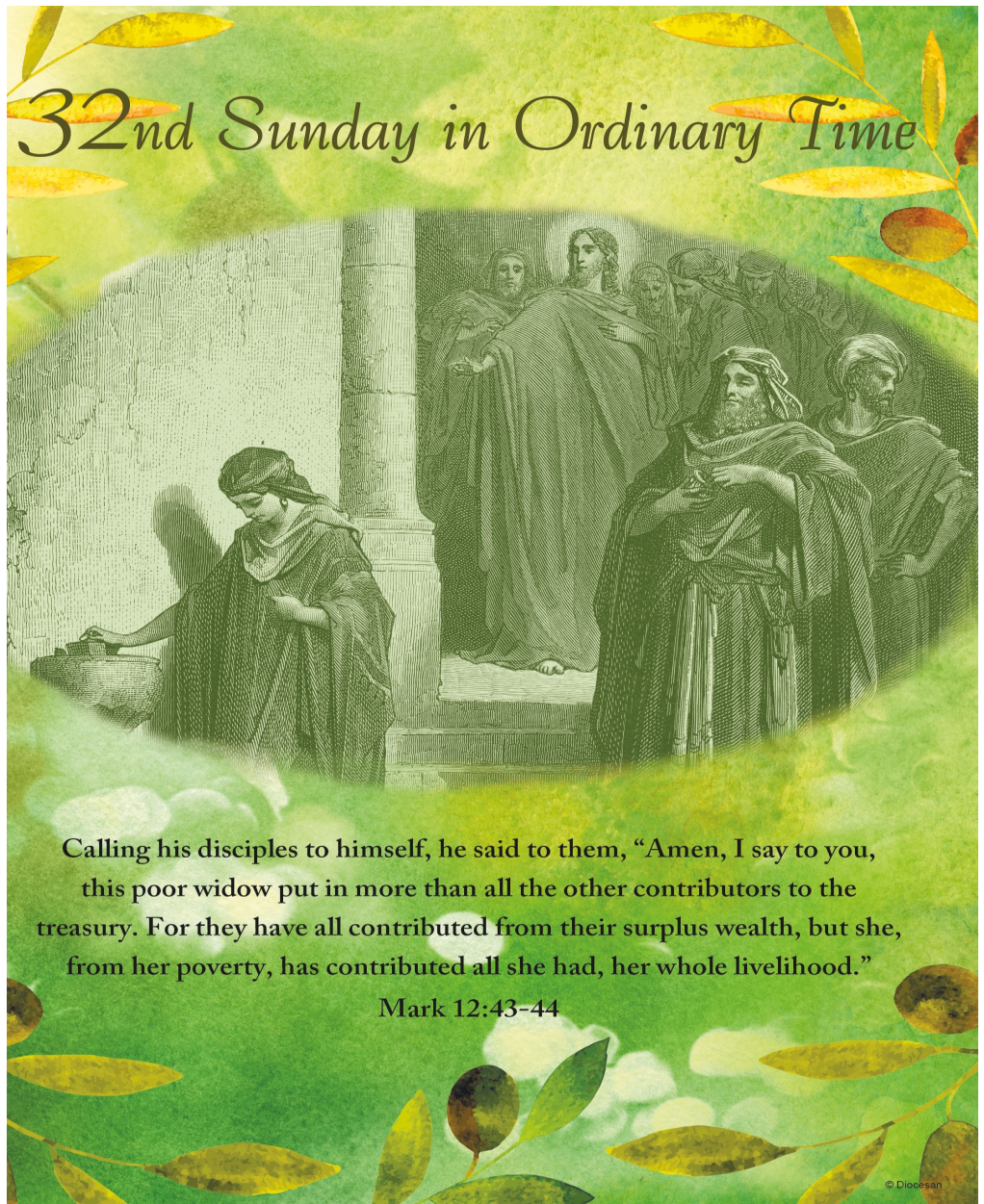

## **BUILDING UPDATE FROM ANDY!**



These years form a partnership with the parents. The first year builds on the faith formation that is ongoing in the home. The second year focuses on direct preparation and reception of the sacrament.
