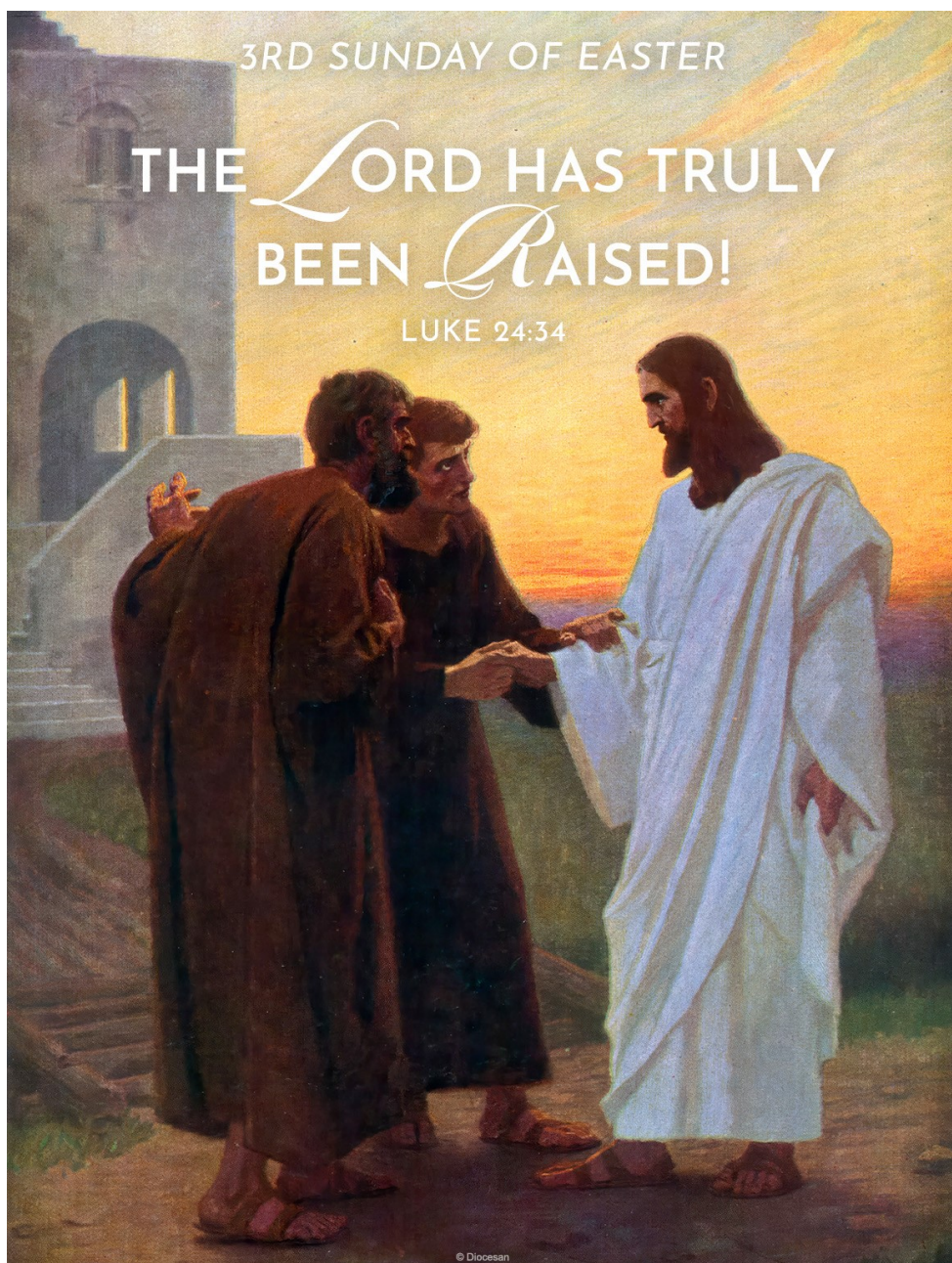

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Parish Family,

As we gather on this Third Sunday of Easter, we are invited to walk alongside the disciples on the road to Emmaus. In their confusion, disappointment, and grief, they did not recognize the Risen Lord walking with them—yet He was there all along.

How often is this true in our own lives? In moments of uncertainty, loss, or discouragement, we may feel that God is distant. Yet today's Gospel reminds us that Jesus is always near—especially in the ordinary moments of our journey.

The turning point for the disciples came in the breaking of the bread. Their eyes were opened, and they recognized Him. This powerful moment reminds us that we, too, encounter the Risen Christ in the Eucharist. Each Mass is an opportunity not only to remember Him, but to truly meet Him.

Filled with renewed faith and joy, the disciples immediately returned to share the Good News. This is our mission as well. Our encounter with Christ is not meant to be kept to ourselves—it is meant to transform us and be shared with others through our words, actions, and love.

Let us ask for the grace:

- to recognize Jesus walking with us each day,
- to encounter Him deeply in the Eucharist,
- and to become joyful witnesses of His Resurrection.

May our hearts, like those of the disciples, burn within us as He speaks to us and reveals Himself in our lives.
