DIVINE MERCY

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Parish Family,

On this Second Sunday of Easter, the Church celebrates Divine Mercy Sunday. This beautiful feast reminds us that the Risen Lord does not come to condemn us, but to pour out His mercy upon the world.

In today's Gospel, the disciples are gathered behind locked doors, afraid and uncertain. Yet Jesus Christ enters their fear and greets them with words that are both comforting and powerful: "Peace be with you." Then He breathes on them and gives them the mission of forgiveness: "Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them." From the very beginning, the Risen Jesus reveals that mercy is at the heart of the Gospel.

This feast was entrusted to the Church through the spiritual experiences of Saint Faustina Kowalska and was officially established for the whole Church by Pope John Paul II in the year 2000. It is a reminder that no sin is greater than God's mercy and that the heart of Christ remains open to every person who turns to Him with trust.

Divine Mercy Sunday invites us to do three simple but powerful things: to trust in God's mercy, to receive His mercy, and to share that mercy with others. We receive His mercy especially through the Sacrament of Reconciliation and the Eucharist. And we share it when we forgive, when we show compassion, and when we choose love instead of resentment.

In a world often marked by division, anger, and indifference, the message of Divine Mercy is more needed than ever. God's merciful love has always the power to transform our hearts, heal our relationships, and renew our communities.

May this celebration renew our confidence in the infinite mercy of God and inspire us to become instruments of that mercy for one another.

May the Risen Lord bless you and your families.
