

PARISH RELIGIOUS EDUCATION PROGRAM (PREP): The PREP

sessions have ended for the year. They will resume in fall. PREP joins with parents of boys and girls in first grade through junior and senior high school in their child's faith formation. Parents are the primary teachers about God and His love and mercy.

Preparation and reception of First Confession, First Communion and/or Confirmation involve a minimum of two (sometimes three) consecutive years in a time of learning, loving and serving God.
