

PARISH RELIGIOUS EDUCATION PROGRAM (PREP): The PREP sessions have ended for the year. They will resume in September. On behalf of the PREP faculty and staff thank you for your prayers and support through the year.

Inquiries regarding faith formation and sacrament preparation for children in elementary through junior and senior high school may be directed to the PREP Office at 954-467-7749 or email: religioused@stanthonyftl.org.

Preparation and reception of First Confession, First Communion and/or Confirmation involve a minimum of two (sometimes three) years.

ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (OCIA): A group is forming with adults who are interested in receiving Baptism (if not yet received), Confirmation, and Communion in the Catholic Church. Preparation and reception involve a journey into Scripture, Prayer and Reflection about Jesus. Details regarding the process may be directed to the Parish Office 954-463-4614. There are no tickets necessary for this journey!
