Instead, we believe the greater good lies in directing what we have been able to gather to those who are facing the most extreme hardships. Many in the hurricane-affected regions are currently without power, running water, homes, or sufficient food. Their suffering this holiday season will be immense, and we invite you to join us in extending our support to those communities.

Although several vendors and non-profit organizations committed to assisting, the contributions fell far short of meeting the full need.
