**FAITH FORMATION UPDATES:** Religious Education sessions will resume in the fall for boys and girls in first grade through high school.

Preparation for the Sacraments of First Reconciliation (confession), First Eucharist (Communion), and Confirmation involve a minimum of two consecutive years of consistent Mass and class attendance so that proper preparation is experienced.
