The design is a clean, contemporary expression of our current time and place in the 100 plus year history of St. Anthony. The size of the new Center is approximately 17,000 square feet. From any curb angle, there will be lush landscaping with layers of plant materials that beatify the area and fit with the natural feeling of the Victoria Park neighborhood.

The building's exceptional design is compatible but differentiated from the Church to ensure the Church remains the prominent and focal point structure on the property. The new Center is pushed back from the NE 3rd Street making it secondary in hierarchy. Building placement will expose the entire east façade of the Church which currently is hidden from view. This structure position creates a new pedestrian experience with greater appreciation of the stain glass windows. Planned are 8' wide brick pavers that lead to a lush courtyard which serves as a serene gathering place. The Architect of record is Bruce Celenski, Inc.
