

FAITH FORMATION UPDATES: In September religious education sessions for boys and girls in first grade through high school will resume. These sessions support and join with the parents in the faith formation that is ongoing and lived out in the family. Parents are the primary and most important religion teachers of their child.. Preparation for the Sacraments of First Reconciliation (confession), First Eucharist (Communion), and Confirmation involve a minimum of two consecutive years of consistent Mass and class attendance so that proper preparation is experienced.
