“Neither do I condemn you; go and sin no more”

On this Fifth Sunday of Lent, Jesus reveals the power of divine mercy. The woman caught in adultery is brought before Him for judgment, but instead of condemning her, Jesus offers a very important lesson: “Let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her.”

This moment challenges us to look into our own hearts. It is easy to judge others, yet we often forget our own need for conversion. Jesus teaches us that true justice is always accompanied by mercy. He does not ignore sin, but He opens a path to forgiveness and renewal: “Neither do I condemn you; go and sin no more.”

As we enter the final stretch of Lent, our Saint Anthony community is called to live out Christ’s compassion. May this season of grace help us to receive His forgiveness with humility and to extend it generously to others.
