In today's reading from John 21:1–19, we encounter the beautiful scene of Jesus appearing to His disciples by the Sea of Tiberias. This Sunday, let us be renewed in our own love for the Lord. Let us remember that no matter how we have stumbled, the Risen Christ comes to meet us, offering forgiveness, hope, and a renewed purpose. He calls each one of us to be His witnesses of love and mercy in the world today.
